First Aid

If swallowed, drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

Antidote

Note to Physicians: Carbofuran (Furadan^R) is a reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not use oximes such as 2-PAM. Start by giving two mg. atropine intramuscularly. According to clinical response, continue until signs of atropinization occur (dry mouth or dilated pupils).

If in eye, install one drop of homatropine.
