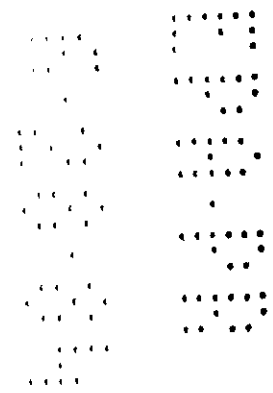

Do not exceed 400 gallons per acre. Make application with ground equipment, using sufficient water to obtain uniform coverage. Begin applications at pink bud and repeat at 10-14 day intervals or as insect and disease conditions warrant. Do not apply during bloom. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not make more than 6 applications per season. Do not graze livestock in treated orchards.
