STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage
Do not store below 25°C. Product may crystallize at temperatures below 25°C (77°F). In the event that crystallization occurs, the material may be melted at temperatures not to exceed 85°C (185°F). Store in original containers only. Store in a dry place and avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers. After partial use, replace lids and close tightly. Do not put concentrate or dilute material into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
