RE: COMMAND TECHNICAL (CLOMAZONE A.I.), EPA REG. NO. 279-3052; AMENDED LABEL, ADMINISTRATIVE LETTER DATED MAY 22, 2009.

Your amended label request for Command Technical, with EPA Reg. No. 279-3052, is "approved with comments" with the following changes to the label:

- Change "Beans A(Succulent)" to "Snap Beans, succulent".
- Remove "Tuberous and corm vegetables", and replace with the specific names of the crop uses you wish to register as identified under 180.41(c) Crop Subgroup 1D under Crop Group 1: Root and Tuber Vegetables Group. For example add, "Arracacha, arrowroot, artichoke, and/or any other member of Crop Subgroup 1D.

This label with comments replaces all preceding labels. The above changes become effective no later than 18 months from the date of this letter.

Submit a revised final printed label before shipping product.
