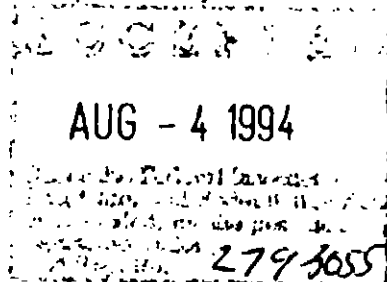

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage

Do not freeze. Do not store below 40° F. If freezing conditions are observed, warm material to above 60° F. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store in a warm location. Shake or roll container to redissolve solids.

Keep out of reach of children and animals. Containers only. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store near heat. Carefully open containers. A. Replace lids and close tightly. Do not put dilute material into food or drink containers. Do not mix with other pesticides, fertilizers, water by storage or disposal.

In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area and animals and unprotected persons. Confine spill (1-800-331-3148).

To confine spill: If liquid, dike surrounding area with sand, cat litter or commercial clay. Cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged container in a holding container. Identify contents.
