3. Since use in nonfood areas is intended, the following must be placed on the label:

NONFOOD AREAS - Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling).

4. For Wasps and Bees Kill, add the statement, "Apply in late afternoon when insects are at rest."

5. Add the statement "Only for Sale to, Use and Storage by Pest Control Operators."

6. Add the following statement to the precautionary section of labeling:

Do not use in the edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed.  
Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

7. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### Hazards to Humans (and Domestic Animals)

#### Warning

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. May cause allergic skin reactions.

## ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Care should be used when spraying to avoid fish and reptile pets.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

### Pesticide Storage

Do not store below 10 F, (-12 C).

Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers. After partial use, replace lids and close tightly. Do not put concentrate or dilute material into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area or absorb with sand, cat litter or commercial clay. If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.

### Pesticide Disposal

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

### Container Disposal

Metal Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and local procedures. Do not cut or weld metal containers.

Plastic Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

## CRACKDOWN WP Insecticide

For residual pest control in and on buildings and structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. Permitted areas of use include, but are not limited to stores, warehouses, industrial buildings, houses, apartment buildings, greenhouses, laboratories, and on vessels, rail cars, buses, trucks, trailers, and aircraft. Also may be used in non-food areas of schools, nursing homes, hospitals, restaurants, hotels, and food manufacturing, processing, and servicing establishments.

CRACKDOWN WP insecticide is intended for dilution with water for spray application. Do not use strainers finer than 50 mesh size. Fill sprayer with one half of the desired volume of water, add CRACKDOWN WP, and fill to desired volume. Close and shake before use in order to insure proper suspension of the wettable powder. Shake or re-agitate the sprayer before use if spraying is interrupted. Make up only as required. Repeat treatments as necessary.

**COCKROACHES, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, and FIREBRATS:** Apply as a coarse, low pressure spray to areas where these pests hide, such as baseboards, corners, storage areas, closets, around water pipes, doors and windows, attics and eaves, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks, furnaces, and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers and similar areas. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices; also see OUTDOOR USE.

**ANTS:** Apply to any trails, around doors and windows, and other places where ants may be found. To prevent infestation apply a BARRIER TREATMENT as described below; also see OUTDOOR USE.

**WASPS and BEES:** Thoroughly spray nest and entrance and surrounding areas where insects alight; also see OUTDOOR USE.

**SOWBUGS, PILLBUGS, MILLIPEDES, and CENTIPEDES:** Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may be found or where they may enter premises. Spray baseboards, storage areas and other locations. To prevent infestation apply a BARRIER TREATMENT as described below; also see OUTDOOR USE.

FLIES: Apply directly to walls, ceilings, window screens, and other fly resting areas as a residual surface treatment. May be used inside residential buildings as well as in and around carports, garages, and storage sheds; also see OUTDOOR USE.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which food is held, processed, prepared or served:

NON-FOOD AREAS: CRACKDOWN WP insecticide may be used as a general crack and crevice treatment in non-food areas. All areas where insects hide or through which insects may enter should be treated.

FOOD AREAS: CRACKDOWN WP insecticide is not labeled for use in food areas. Do not use in any area where food or feed is stored, prepared, or consumed.

OUTDOOR USE: For control of ants, bees, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, firebrats, millipedes, silverfish, sowbugs, pillbugs, spiders, flies, and wasps. Apply as a residual spray to surfaces of buildings, porches, screens window frames, eaves, patios, lawns, refuse dumps, garages and other areas where pests are found by either hand or power sprayer.

BARRIER TREATMENTS: To help prevent infestation of buildings, apply to a band of soil and vegetation 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the building. Also, treat the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply as a coarse spray to thoroughly and uniformly wet the band area, using 1 gallon of spray mix per 400 square feet.

Do not apply this product to edible crops.

CAUTION: Do not use water base sprays of CRACKDOWN WP insecticide in conduit motor housings, junction boxes, switch boxes, or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Let surfaces dry before allowing children and pets to contact surfaces. Protect aquariums from spray mist. Thoroughly wash out sprayer and screen with water and detergent before using CRACKDOWN insecticide. Do not use this product with oil.
