6). Generate additional neurotoxicity studies with cypermethrin-s if EPA concludes after review of the studies conducted with cypermethrin that additional testing is necessary.

7). Submit a revised confidential statement of formula based on five production batches, with correct nomenclature for the isomers of the active ingredient and impurities by June 30, 1994,

8). Submit a reference sample of Fury Technical as well as a material safety data sheet to the Chemical Standard Repository by June 30, 1992,

9). Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

a Add the phrase, "EPA Registration Number 279-3124."

b Revise the subheading above the practical treatment section to read, "STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT."

c The following statement must be added under the sub-heading Directions for Use:

"ONLY FOR FORMULATION INTO AN INSECTICIDE FOR THE FOLLOWING USE (S): COTTON, LETTUCE AND PECANS. USES FOR WHICH U.S. EPA HAS ACCEPTED THE REQUIRED DATA AND/OR CITATIONS OF DATA THAT THE FORMULATOR HAS SUBMITTED IN SUPPORT OF REGISTRATION; AND USES FOR EXPERIMENTAL PURPOSES THAT ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH U.S. EPA REQUIREMENTS."

d The precautionary section should be revised to include the statement, "The active ingredient may cause sensenitization reaction in some individual."
