Container Disposal

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse [or pressure rinse] as follows:

Triple rinse: Empty the remaining contents into a storage container or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with appropriate solvent (1). Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into a storage container for later use or disposal, or into a mix tank for product formulation. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Pressure rinse: Empty the remaining contents into a storage container or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over storage container or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.

Then offer for recycling, if available, or reconditioning, if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration. Do not burn, unless allowed by state or local ordinances. If burned, stay out of smoke.
