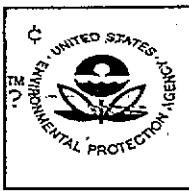

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or if available by administering syrup of ipecac. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

**IF INHALED:** Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

**IF ON SKIN:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation occurs and persists.

**This product is for sale to and use by utility industry personnel only.** For use in and around buried cables, telephone pedestals, cable television pedestals, pad-mounted electric power transformers, underground vaults, ground mounted utility cabinets and utility poles. Do not open contents until ready for use. Open bag and pour entire contents (4 oz) directly into and around buried closure or hole. Lock closure or set pole immediately to prevent access. One bag will treat buried closures up to 12" x 12" (1 sq. ft.).

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

#### Pesticide Storage

Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in a clean, dry place. Protect bag from rupture during storage and transport. If contents are spilled, sweep or scoop up material and place in another clean, dry container for reuse or disposal in accordance with this label.
