



FirstLine Termite Bait Container Station is ready to use and filled with a treated cellulosic matrix containing 100 ppm sulfiluramid, a slow acting insecticide. The use of this bait suppresses or controls termite infestations. The termite activity depends on the species involved, weather, moisture, and the time of year. Termites may require 1 to 4 months or more for control. Permitted areas of use include commercial, industrial, institutional and residential buildings and structures such as, houses, apartment buildings, laboratories, stores, warehouses, schools, nursing homes, hospitals, restaurants, hotels, churches, food manufacturroundings. The bait is effective against: Coptotermes, Heterotermes, and Reliculitermes termites. Indoor applications are limited to soil installation only.

For Structures With an Active Infestation

For use around residential structures, do not apply more than one FirstLine™ Termite Bait Container Station.


