On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 279-3172."
- b. The labeling must specify "For Residential Lawn Use Only."
- c. Delete the statement beginning with "Which means lower impact, and ending with found in chrysanthemums." Terms stating or implying safety to the environment are not acceptable.
- d. Delete the statement "TalStar has a long residual, providing many weeks, etc..." or specify the time period of residual effectiveness. In addition, the residual time period must be supported by efficacy data.

- e. The chemical name for Bifenthrin as listed in the ingredient statement should be corrected to read as follows: "(2-methyl[1,1'-biphenyl]methyl 3-(2-dimethyl-cyclopropanecarboxylate)."
- f. The net weight of the product must be specified on the bottom front panel of the labeling in accordance with 40 CFR § 156.10 (d).
- g. As proposed, the appropriate signal is CAUTION. However, the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT must be revised to read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed. . Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

- h. Based on the results of the acute toxicity data submitted under "TalStar 0.2 Lawn Granular Insecticide, EPA Reg. No. 279-3163", for which this product is relying upon for registration, only the "If Swallowed and If In Eyes" STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT instructions are required.
- i. Under Surface Feeding Lawn Insects qualify free ants with the term foraging i.e., "foraging free ants."
- j. With respect to fire ants, add an asterisk to fire ants and beneath the paragraph add *aids in control. It is unclear if the product is to be watered in after application (please explain). Also correct the rate of application to teaspoons/tablespoons since it would be difficult for the homeowner to measure 0.8 ounces.

3. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Talstar is designed for use as a ready-to-use granular insecticide to control various insects and spiders on lawns. Please read the following "Directions for Use" carefully and fully before applying this product.

Surface Feeding Lawn Insects

Use Talstar for the control of ants, including Carpenter, Red Harvester, Pavement, Odorous Pyramid, Argentine, Pharoah (Sugar) and Fire Ants, Armyworms, Centipedes, Chiggers, Chinch Bugs, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, Grasshoppers, Fleas, Millipedes, Scorpions, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moth), Sow Bugs, Spiders, Ticks (including Brown Dog Ticks) and Weevils (including Hyperodes). Uniformly apply 2.4 pounds over a 1,000 sq. ft. area of lawn using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for the application of granular materials. A 12 pound bag will treat a 5,000 sq. ft. area of lawn. Best results are obtained if the treated area is thoroughly watered immediately after application. Treat when insects first appear and retreat as necessary.

Mole Crickets

Uniformly apply 4.8 pounds over a 1,000 sq. ft. area of lawn. For best results: treat in late spring, and water the treated area thoroughly immediately after application.

For Fire Ant Mounds

To control Fire ants, uniformly apply 0.8 ounces of Talstar to the surface of each mound. For best results, 1) apply in cool weather, 65 to 80 °F, or in early morning or late evening hours, 2) avoid disturbing ants, 3) treat new mounds as they appear and 4) thoroughly water the treated area immediately after application.
