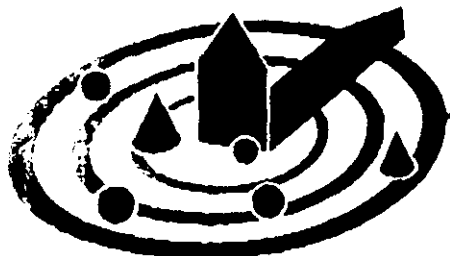

Caution

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Drift and run-off from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do not apply more than 580 pounds of Talstar® 0.069 GCGU Granular Insecticide with 19-0-19 Fertilizer per acre per year.

Do not apply by air.

Do not apply within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries, and commercial fish farm ponds.

Grass Application: Broadcast Talstar® 0.089 GCGU Granular Insecticide with 3-0-19 Fertilizer with suitable application equipment to ensure uniform coverage over the treatment area. Apply 8.66 pounds per 1,000 square feet to control the following pests.
