



Perimeter Application: Apply to ground area 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the structure using an application rate of 3.13 to 6.25 pounds per 1,000 square feet.

Grass Application: Broadcast Talstar® 0.073 GCGURR Granular Insecticide with 19-0-19 Fertilizer with suitable application equipment to ensure uniform coverage over the treatment area. Apply 3.13 to 6.25 pounds per 1,000 square feet to control the following pests.

Comments

¹Deer ticks (*Ixodes sp.*) have a complicated life cycle that ranges over a two year period and involves four life stages. Applications should be made in mid to late-spring to control larvae and nymphs that reside in the soil and leaf litter.

²Imported Fire ants: Control will be optimized by combining broadcast applications that will control foraging workers and newly mated fly-in queens with mound treatments (using Talstar GC Flowable) that will eliminate existing colonies.

³The higher application rate may be required to control Ants, Centipedes, Fleas, Imported Fire Ants, Millipedes, Mole Crickets & Ticks (Including Deer Ticks).

In New York State, this product may NOT be applied to any grass or turf area within 100 feet of a water body (lake, pond, river, stream, wetland, or drainage ditch).

In New York State, do make a single repeat application of Talstar® 0.073 GCGURR Granular Insecticide with 19-0-19 Fertilizer if there are signs of renewed insect activity, but not sooner than two weeks after the first application.
