Dear Mr. Davis:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

1. Per the Agency's Re-registration Eligibility Decision (RED) document for cypermethrin products, you must add the following statements to the Directions for Use:
 - a. "This product must not be formulated into end-use products that contain directions for use on sod farms, agricultural uncultivated areas, fencerows, hedgerows, or rights-of-way. These use sites must be removed from all end-use product labels and any special need registration must be canceled."
 - b. "This product must not be formulated into wettable powder end use formulations unless they are packaged in water soluble bags."

A copy of the label stamped "accepted with comments" is enclosed for your records. You must submit two copies of the final printed label revised in accordance with the comments listed above before the product is released for shipment under this label. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Residual Storage

Do not store below 40°F.

Container Disposal

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or pressure rinse) as follows:

Triple rinse: Empty the remaining contents into a storage container or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with appropriate solvent¹. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into a storage container for later use or disposal, or into a mix tank for product formulation. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Pressure rinse: Empty the remaining contents into a storage container or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over storage container or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 psi for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.

Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. If rinsate cannot be used, follow pesticide disposal instructions. If not triple rinsed, these containers are acute hazardous wastes and must be disposed in accordance with local, state and federal regulations. DO NOT cut or weld metal containers.

¹ An appropriate solvent would include a solvent that will dissolve technical material. The rinsate may be used later to formulate a product or may be disposed in accordance with local, state and national environmental laws, rules, standards and regulations.
