Dear Mr. Davis:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Provide field data for termites demonstrating at least 2 years of effectiveness of the AI at the application rate.
2. Provide plastic sheet thickness specified on the label under various storage conditions against target pest insects within 36 months.
3. Submit protocol for review prior to initiation of the field trials.
4. Submit or cite data in support of ant claims.
5. With respect to the labeling statements, page 3, revise the final statement as follows:

“For use in the manufacture of plastic sheeting(film) to protect it from subterranean termites. Incorporate Talstar 2% MB Insecticide into plastic sheeting to a maximum concentration of 0.1% wt/wt and minimum film thickness

- 6. Finished sheeting may have the following labeling:

“Plastic sheeting (or company’s trade name for sheeting) contains bifenthrin to protect the sheeting(film) from subterranean termites.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
