

Pesticide Storage

Do not store below 10°F (-12°C).

Do not use or store near heat, open flame or hot surfaces.

Shake for 10 seconds, Pour rinsate into application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times Then offer for recycling if available, or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities. Do not cut or weld metal containers.
