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2. You must generate studies corresponding to guidelines 830.6317 (one year storage stability) and 830.6320 (corrosion characteristics). The results must be submitted to the Agency along with an electronic format.

3. You submit a copy of the enforcement analytical method to the EPA Analytical Laboratory at: EPA Analytical Laboratory, 701 Mapes Road, Ft. Mead, MD 20755-5350.

4. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Registration Number 279-3341."
- b. Replace the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section with "Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes and gloves." Also add "Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."
- c. You may delete the "If Inhaled" and "If on Skin or Clothing" precautions since the studies were classified as category IV.
- d. Add "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: The following statements are suggested types of information which may be included, if applicable: technical information on symptomatology;- use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions;- medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;- company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice."
- e. Please revise your label in accordance with PR Notice 2007-4.

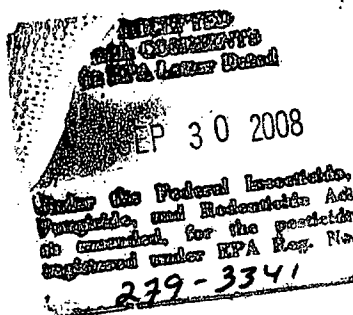
