The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the referenced product in connection with the pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide and MGK 264 RED(s), and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

PLEASE NOTE: This product is <u>not</u> being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

A copy of your label stamped "Acceptable" is enclosed along with copies of the acute toxicity and product chemistry reviews completed for the subject product. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO USE THE PRODUCT CORRECTLY:

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets either directly or through drift. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs. Do not apply into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to storm sewers, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Not for use in residential misting systems.

Shake Well Before Use. This product will kill Cockroaches, Ants, Flies, Mosquitoes, Fleas, Ticks, Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Crickets, Spiders, Small Flying Moths, and Sowbugs.

<u>For residential applications:</u> Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before use. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two hours. If an odor is still detected additional ventilation is required.

For non-residential applications: Do not apply when food processing facility is in operation or foods are exposed. Cover or remove all food and food processing equipment before application. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. Food areas include areas for receiving, storage, packaging (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas are places where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but not excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Non-food areas include entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning and bottling). Do not treat establishments where livestock feed is present.

BEFORE YOU FOG:

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Extinguish all flames including pilot lights. IMPORTANT! To avoid FLAMMABILITY HAZARDS use as follows: DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets, or under counters or tables. Use of a fogger in an enclosed space may cause the product to explode, resulting in injury to people or damage to property. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 25' x 25' with an 8 foot ceiling). Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

TO START FOGGING:

TO OPERATE VALVE: Place several layers of newspaper or pad on stand or table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table with valve locked open. Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit, or other structure immediately. Fill out and place hang-tag on the door to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hours.


AIRING OUT:

Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.


Restrictions











-Do not use multiple canisters in a room

-Turn off ignition sources

No flames or pilot lights

-Remove or cover exposed food

-Air out the room before entering



-Do not use in small, confined areas.



Do not re-enter for 2 hours

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool dry area away from children.
