Residual action will kill wasps and hornets returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To Kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets and Bees under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes or crevices wherever insects are noticed. Spray until the surface is just damp, but not to the point of runoff. Avoid excess application. To prevent entrance of insects into the house, spray around points where insects enter such as outside plumbing, faucets, etc., and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
