

Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into a storage container for later use or disposal, or into a mix tank for product formulation. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling, if available, or reconditioning, if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration. Do not burn, unless allowed by state or local ordinances. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Pressure rinse: Empty the remaining contents into a storage container or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over storage container or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal.
