For Use As Stable Spray - For use in the stable, mix 1/2 cup of Martin's Horse Fly Bomb with 1 gallon of water. Spray the mixture in the stable, especially around the horse's head and neck. Repeat the application every 2-3 days.

For Use on Horses: To protect against attacks of horse flies, stable flies, horn flies, mosquitoes, and gnats, hold container 12 to 18 inches away from animal and depress valve. Spray each side of animal, wetting the ends of the mane. Avoid wetting the animal's skin. Treat animal once each day, preferably in the morning. Repeat at daily intervals or as necessary for continued protection. Do not overapply to animals. Do not use on dairy animals or animals intended for slaughter.

For Use As Space Spray: For quick knockdown and kill of flies, mosquitoes, and gnats in horse stables, spray toward ceiling and corners until space is filled with a light mist. For best results, close all windows and doors prior to spraying and keep them closed for 10 to 15 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Do not use in dairy barns.
