WASPS - Spray directly on insects whenever possible and under eaves into nests, cracks, holes or crevices, contacting as many insects as possible. Spray until surface areas are moist. To prevent entrance of insects into house, spray around points of outside plumbing where it enters the house and into cracks and crevices in foundation. Spray around window sills and doorways until moist.

SCORPIONS - Spray until moist around windows, doors and other areas where these pests may crawl or attempt to enter the house. Frequently scorpions are found in attics.

FLIES, GNATS, ANTS, MOSQUITOES, ROACHES, SPIDERS AND CHIGGERS - Spot spray areas around patios, porches and picnic locations where pests congregate.

ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, WATERBUGS - Spray into cracks and around doors, windows and wherever these insects rest, hide or run. Be sure a deposit of spray coats the surface.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Avoid inhalation or skin contact. Wash thoroughly after using. Keep away from eyes or other mucous membranes. If eyes come in contact with this product, flush with water and contact a Physician. Do not spray on pets, vegetation, or into ponds, streams or lakes.
