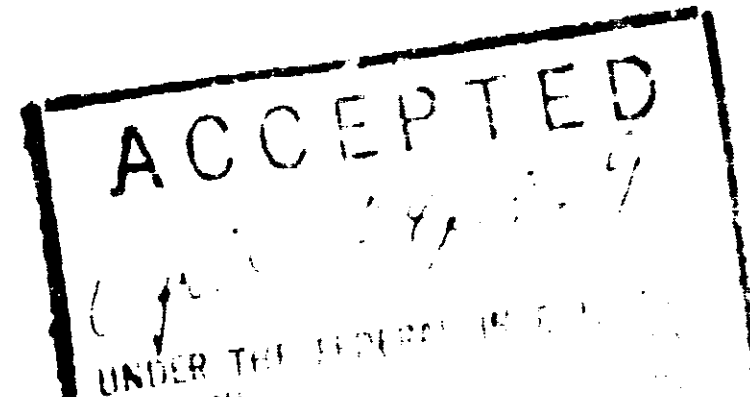

DIRECTIONS:

Spray surfaces wherever flies, gnats, household ants, spiders and mosquitoes congregate. **ON PATIOS,** spray thoroughly—tables, chairs and wall surfaces in vicinity of charcoal grill. However, do not use near heat or open flame. Avoid direct contact with food or food utensils. For **PICNIC LOCATIONS,** spray picnic tables and all other surfaces where flies, gnats and mosquitoes congregate. Also spray surfaces where household ants are seen. **ON PORCHES,** spray on walls, chairs and tables wherever these insects congregate. Repeat application as needed.

FOR INDOOR USE against spiders, flies, gnats and mosquitoes, close up the infested area and fill it with mist. Direct spray upward toward all parts of room. For roaches, ants, silverfish and water bugs, spray into cracks to drive them out, then spray directly on insects. Also spray generously around doors and windows wherever these insects rest, hide or run. Avoid direct contact with food or food utensils.

CAUTION: Keep away from eyes or other mucous membranes. Avoid inhaling. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contamination of feed or food-stuffs. Do not use on humans or household pets. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after using. Remove birds, pets and fish bowls before spraying room.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130 degrees Fahrenheit, may cause bursting.
