or three inches outside the infestation. Repeat treatment twice weekly until infestation is controlled.

TREATMENT OF SCREW-WORM INFESTATIONS IN SUPERFICIAL CUTS OR WOUNDS:

Spray directly into and one inch around infested wounds. Also spray drainage area below wound. Repeat treatment twice weekly until wound heals.

PROTECTION AGAINST SCREW WORMS:

Spray all wounds (wire cuts, dehorning, castration, docking, etc.) as soon as possible to prevent screwworm infestation. Repeat treatment twice weekly until wound heals.

FLEECE WORMS AND OTHER BLOW FLIES:

Spray directly on infested areas and to a distance of two
