The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
(Continued)

Use Dursban Lawn Spray to control Chinch Bugs, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moths), Armyworms, Ants, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, Grasshoppers, Pillbugs, Brown Dog Ticks, and Fleas on home lawns and other ornamental turf areas. Mix with water according to directions given in the following table and apply uniformly as a coarse (large nozzel) spray using a low pressure sprayer.

Area To Be Treated	Amount of Dursban Lawn Spray	Dilute With Water to Make
750 sq. ft.	1 pint	25 gallons
1500 sq. ft.	1 quart	50 gallons
6000 sq. ft.	1 gallon	200 gallons

Make first treatment when insects first appear and retreat as needed. The lawn should be moist at the time of application.

For individual fire ant mounds, apply Dursban Lawn Spray as a drench, diluted at the rate of 15.5 fl. oz. (465 ml) per 4 gallons of water. Gently sprinkle a total of 1 gallon of the diluted emulsion over the surface of each mound using a gentle spray (such as a sprinkler can). Thoroughly wet mound and surrounding areas to a 4 ft. diameter (12 sq. ft.). For best results, apply in cool weather, 65-80° F. or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear. Pressurized sprays may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.
