Spray or wash animals thoroughly. Do not apply within 28 days of slaughter. Do not use on animals under 3 months old. For Mange control, repeat treatment at 7-10 day intervals for two or more applications, as needed. In cases of light infestation one application may be adequate. Repeat as necessary for lice.

BEEF CATTLE AND HORSES

To control Scables (Psoroptic, Sarcoptic and Chorioptic Mange), Lone Star Ticks, Cattle Ticks, Winter Ticks, Gulf Coast Ticks, Hornflies, Cattle Lice, Ear Ticks. Mix I gallon with 150 gallons of water. The roughly wet animals by spraying or dipping. For early any use mixt sprayer and apply into each earland to head and neck. Repeat treatment at 7 to 10 day intervals for two or more applications as needed for scables control. Repeat as necessary for control of other insects. Do not apply within 28 days of slaughter. BACK RUBBERS

As an aid in the control of Hornflies and Lice on beef cattle: Mix I quart with 5 galions of kerosene or diesel fuel. Fill tank of backrubber device or soak burlap roll with solution so it is troroughly wet but not to point of dripping. Recharge as necessary. Do not permit animals access to treatment within 28 days of slaughter. Do not permit access to backrubbers by dairy animals or calves under 5 months old.

SHEEP AND GOATS

To control Psoroptic Sheep Scab, Eleeceworms, Hornflies, Lone Star Ticks, Ear Ticks: Mix I gallon with 150 gallons of water. Thoroughly examinals by spraying or dipping. For ear ticks, use a mist sprayer and apply into each ear and to head and neck. Repeat treatment at 7 to 10 dly intervals for two or more applications as needed for scabies control. Repeat as necessary for other insects.

For control Lice and Sheep Ticks (Keds). As a dip, use I gallon with 800 gallons of water. For spraying, I gallon with 200 gallons of water will give best results. Thoroughly wet an mals. Repeat as necessary.
