DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply spray to the animal from a distance of 8 to 12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. As you spray, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate into the fur. Make sure spray wets ticks. For cats, spray on the basis of a 4 to 6 second application to a 5 pound animal. For dogs, spray on the basis of a 20 to 30 second application to a 25 pound animal. Repeat treatments, if necessary, should not be more often than once weekly. Do not spray into the eyes, face or scrotum. Do not overspray.

Spray animal's living quarters and bedding, attempting to contact directly as many insects as possible.
