How to Mix and Apply

Step 1: Determine size of spraying job. For lawns and vegetables, measure the area to be sprayed. For all other applications apply a thorough cover spray. Make applications when insects first appear or in advance of an expected infestation. Repeat applications as needed as indicated in the rate chart.

Step 2: Use clean sprayer. Carefully wash sprayer with water. Use **LAWN AND GARDEN INSECT CONTROL** and water as directed in the chart below.

Step 3: Spray as directed in rate chart. Use a ground application nozzle for lawn, soil, and other surface applications. Use a misting nozzle for trees and plants. Thorough coverage is important. Wash sprayer with clean water after each use.
