Martin's Diazinon Household Insect Spray
EPA Registration No. 299-196
Your Letter Dated November 29, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide, Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. We assume your product name will remain "Martin's Diazinon Household Insect Spray." The label submitted failed to include the word "Martin's." If this is not the case, please request an official product name change.
 - b. Under your active ingredients add an asterisk beside the word "Technical." In addition, place another asterisk below the word "Total" followed by the wording "Equivalent to 0.208% [butyl carbityl]6-propyl piperonyl ether and 0.052% of related compounds."
 - c. Add the word "CAUTION" following the words, "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals."

- d. Under the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statement add, "Harmful if swallowed. Do not use on household pets or humans."
 - e. You must add a Storage and Disposal section as stipulated in PR Notice 83-3 (copy enclosed). Please refer to this Notice for the appropriate wording.
 - f. We note that the amount of petroleum distillate on the label is slightly less than the amount actually contained in the product. This is acceptable.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in and around the home. Spray infested surfaces until wet. For spot application only. Do not use a space spray. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPRINGTAILS, SPIDERS, FIREBRANTS, CRICKETS, EARWIGS: Spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, ant trails and other localized areas infested with insects. Spray around window sills and door frames where ants enter. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks and infested areas of shelving in closets. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Repeat as necessary. Bedding should be replaced in animal quarters after treatment. Do Not treat animals.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, AND FLYING MOTHS - OUTDOORS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surface of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures or porches, in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

CHIGGERS AND BROWN DOG TICKS - OUTDOORS: For treatment of localized infestations of insects, spray weeds and brushy noncrop areas. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of the reach of children. Do not use on household pets or humans.

Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not permit children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Treated area should be vacated during application. Do not contaminate food, feedstuffs, or drinking water.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

IF INHALED - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IN ON SKIN - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IN IN EYES - Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Product contains a high percentage of light petroleum distillate. Gastric lavage is indicated if product was taken internally. Product is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal, and may be administered but only in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply this directly to lakes, streams, and ponds. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment of to residues remaining on sprayed plants. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting plants blooming in the area to be sprayed. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between the time of spraying and the next period of bee activity.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not store below 32 degrees Fahrenheit.
