

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Classification

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CONTROL: ANTS, CHINCH BUGS, SOD WEBWORMS (LAWN MOTHS), BROWN DOG TICKS, CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, EARWIGS, GRASSHOPPERS, AND PILLBUGS INFESTING HOME LAWNS AND OTHER ORNAMENTAL TURF AREAS:

Uniformly apply Dursban* Insecticide Granules using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using Dursban* Insecticide Granules at the rate of 200 lbs. per acre. Immediately after application, sprinkle the turf with 1300 gallons of water per acre so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the following table to determine amounts of Dursban* Insecticide Granules and water needed for smaller sized areas. Re-treat as necessary.

RATES TO USE

Area to be Treated	Pounds of Dursban* Insecticide Granules	Gallons of Water to Sprinkle on Turf After Treatment
1000 Sq. Ft.	5	30
5000 Sq. Ft.	25	150
10000 Sq. Ft.	50	325

TO CONTROL CERTAIN WHITE GRUBS (LARVAE OF EUROPEAN CHAFER AND JAPANESE BEETLE): Use two to four times the amount of Dursban* Insecticide Granules shown in the table above. Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated followed immediately by thorough watering to wash the insecticide into the turf. For best results, treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.

TO CONTROL HYPERODES (TURFGRASS) WEEVIL: Use twice the rate of Dursban* Insecticide Granules shown in the above table. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.

Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry. Keep out of fish ponds and other bodies of water. Do not apply where run-off is likely to occur.
