PT 550F Resmethrin

DIRECTIONS

WARNING: Do not use this product in a manner inconsistent with the instructions.

1. **INSECTS:** Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Weevils, Small Flying Insects. These use all windows and doors and direct fly upward at a rate of 1000 cubic feet. Disperse in all locations. Sweep area covered by insects. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment at 24 hours.

2. **PATIENTS:** Patients should be removed from the room prior to treatment. Return patients to room after surviving. Do not return patients until after ventilation.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and dispose in a safe manner.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE IN HOTELS, MOTELS, INSTITUTIONS, PACKAGING AND PROCESSING PLANTS, SEED HOUSES AND HORSE STABLES.

Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

SPACE SPRAY: To kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats: Close room or area to be treated. Shut off air conditioner and ventilator system. Seal all open vents. Remove fish and pets. Apply undiluted as a very fine mist space spray through manually operated equipment or with electrical and other powered applicators. Avoid staining by holding the spray nozzle at least five feet from objects. Direct the fine spray mist toward the upper corner of the room. Fill the room with a fine mist space spray at the rate of 5 fluid ounces per 1,000 cubic feet. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy insects.

CONTACT SPRAY: To kill roaches, ants, earwigs, grain mites, sawbugs, spiders and centipedes: Adjust spray to produce large wetting type spray particles. Direct spray to contact these insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets, and other harborage. Spray these infested areas until thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray doors, around window frames, ant trails and hills.

TO KILL GRAIN INSECTS: Adults of confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles: Remove infested grain cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and foodstuffs in the area by removing before spraying. Spray directly on exposed stages and into cracks and crevices where grain insects may be hiding.

Caution:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing mist.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For skin and eyes, call a physician.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Extinguish open flame before space spraying. This formulation is combustible. DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL, OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PRECAUTIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture, or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill, or bury in a safe place. A container size of 30 gals. or more may be re-rinsed and offered for reconditioning.

GENERAL: Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternate procedures.
