PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS
AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER: Convulsive Poison! Poisonous if swallowed. Do not breathe dust. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Keep away from children, pets and domestic animals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Clean clothing should be used daily. Do not touch bait with bare hands. Wear gloves while handling bait.

This product is to be used only for subsoil application as directed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: CALL A PHYSICIAN OR POISON CONTROL CENTER IMMEDIATELY. If less than ten (10) minutes have passed since the poison was taken, give 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have patient lie down in quiet, darkened room and keep warm and quiet. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

A. Administer 100% Oxygen by positive pressure to provide as much pulmonary gas exchange as possible despite seizures.

B. Administer ANTICONVULSANT DRUGS intravenously to control convulsions.

CAUTION: It may be difficult or impossible to stop the seizure activity without stopping respiration. Be prepared to maintain pulmonary ventilation mechanically. Tracheotomy may be necessary if seizures are prolonged.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Baits exposed on soil surfaces may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

ENDANGERED SPECIES CONSIDERATIONS

NOTICE: The killing of a member of an endangered species during strychnine baiting operations may result in a fine under the Endangered Species Act. Before baiting, the user is advised to contact the Regional U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Endangered Species Specialist) or the local Fish

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may be used to control pocket gophers (*Citellus thomomys* spp., and *Papogomys* spp.) in rangelands, croplands, and noncrop areas. Do not use this product by use of a mechanical burrower. Do not apply this product above ground over any crops or anywhere else.

BAITING: Remove burrow plug from the burrow fan or locate the main runway with a metal rod or wooden stick. Resista probe will decrease when you are in the way. Insert one tablespoon of bait into the burrow system, using a long-handled spoon if necessary. Close the tunnel with soil. Do not partially cover bait. One pound of bait will treat approximately one acre, depending upon the number of acres to be treated. Retreat according to above directions if no activity is noticed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a locked area out of reach of children, pets and animals. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of solid or liquid wastes is a violation of the Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, the Hazardous Waste representative at the EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse or refill container. Completely empty then dispose of container by incineration, or if allowed by local authorities, by burning. If burned, do not breathe fumes.

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
