### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use.

#### PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

#### PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

#### CONTAINER DISPOSAL

##### PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out smoke.

#### GENERAL

Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.

For industrial and institutional use.

Solution	San Pheno X	Water
1% (1:200)	1 1/2 oz.	2 gal.
.67% (1:150)	1 oz.	1 gal.
1% (1:100)	1 1/2 oz.	1 gal.
2% (1:40)	2 1/2 oz.	1 gal.

**USES:** Floors, walls rubber sheeting, painted surfaces, metals, plastic, tubing and empty basins.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply with mop sponge or cloth. For disinfecting, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits; then, thoroughly wet surfaces at 1:200 (1 1/2%) dilution. For use as a fungicide, dilute 1:150. For rubber sheeting, use stiff brush or sponge and soak in solution for 10 minutes. For tubing, immerse in solution for 10 minutes. Rinsing is not necessary on floors except if surface is to be waxed or polished. Heat treatment for sporicidal action, dilute 1:40 (2 1/2%) and boil 10 minutes.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed promptly drink a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

##### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

**CORROSIVE:** Do not get in eyes or skin. Causes skin and eye damage. Protect eyes with goggles or face shield and skin with rubber gloves when handling the concentrate. Gloves should also be worn when handling the diluted product. Do not get on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Rinse empty container with water and discard it.
