A.O.A.C. Use Dilution Confirmation Tests:

Kills Salmonella choleraesuis 1 to 256
Kills Staphylococcus aureus 1 to 256
Kills Pseudomonas aeruginosa 1 to 256

A.O.A.C. Tuberculocidal Activity Test:

Kills M. tuberculosis 1 to 256

A.O.A.C. Fungicidal Test:

Kills Trichophyton interdigitale 1 to 256

DILUTION: 1:256 1/2 ounce per gallon

USE: Matar may be used on floors, furniture, porcelain, rubber, thermometers, lensed instruments, metals, walls, equipment, paint, plastic, linens, tubing, basins and for carpet sanitation.

APPLICATION: Apply with mop, sponge or rag. Also spray or soak. Rinsing is not necessary on floors, except if surface is to be waxed or polished. For heavy duty cleaning, increase Matar according to amount of soil.

Active Ingredients: Sodium o-phenylphosphate, Sodium lauryl sulfate, Sodium o-benzyl-p-chlorophenolate, Sodium tertiary amyl phenate, Tetrasodium ethylene diamine tetraacetate, Sodium carbonate, Isopropyl alcohol, Sodium 4-chloro-2-methylphenylphenate, Essential oils 20.4%

Inert Ingredients: Water, 1,1-Propanediol, 2-methyl-2,4-pentanediol, Urea, Sodium tripolyphosphate, Sodium sulfide 71.6%

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
