**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

FMB 6075 is a quaternary germicide. Do not mix with soap or other materials.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children and unauthorized persons. Handle with proper care. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Recycle if possible. Do not reuse empty container.

### PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide spray mixture: concentrate that cannot be used: empty containers, excess stock, or other surplus, and not approved for pesticides, should be turned in a safe place away from water sources.
