#### **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**FIRST AID:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

##### **HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**Corrosive:** Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling the concentrate. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

##### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

##### **PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

FMB 451-15 is a cationic germicide. Do not mix with soap or anionic materials.

#### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

#### **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL**

Pesticide, spray mixture, or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

#### **CONTAINER DISPOSAL**

Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers or bury in a safe place. Consult federal, state, or local authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.

#### **GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. A disinfectant for formulating use only.
