DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not store this water-based formulation at temperatures below 32°F.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State or Local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and Local procedures.

FOR USE IN NON-FOOD AREAS INDOORS AND OUTSIDE PREMISES OF COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL AND INSTITUTIONAL BUILDINGS, IN HOSPITALS, REMOVE PATIENTS PRIOR TO TREATMENT. VENTILATE ROOMS FOR TWO HOURS BEFORE RETURNING PATIENTS.

In food handling establishments, can be used in non-food areas as a contact or residual spray. In food areas application is limited to spot and/or crack and crevice treatment.

NOTE TO USER: One gallon (3.78 L) of spray is sufficient to treat 1500 linear feet (457 m) with a 6 inch (15.2 cm) spray wand. For contact and residual sprays, use this product without diluting. For residual applications, dilute with equal parts of water.

CONTACT SPRAY-KILLS AND REDUCES INFESTATIONS: Cockroaches (kitchenflies), crickets, silverfish (firebrats), cluster flies, centipedes, millipedes, earwigs, sowbugs (pillbugs), spiders, ants, fire ants, carpet beetles, boxelder bugs, scorpions, silverfish, bed bugs, confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, shiny flour beetles, grain moths, red flour beetles, Argentinean grain moths, grain weevils, Indian meal moths, Mediterranean flour moths, lesser grain borers, cigarette beetles, drug store beetles, chocolate moths. Use as a spot treatment when possible. Spray directly on pests to reduce infestations. Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, floor areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators and other appliances, baseboards and storage areas. Apply spray until area is wet, but not to the point of run-off. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS (Including Fire Ants): To kill ants, spray trails, nests and points of entry within buildings. Spray directly on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES AND CLOTHES MOTH: Do not spray clothing with this product. Do not spray clothing to contact areas where this product has been used. Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting, rugs and chairs. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices, closets and enclosed areas of shelving and/or wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

RESIDUAL SPRAY: AIDS IN THE CONTROL OF COCKROACHES (WATERBUGS), CRICKETS, BOXLEAFER BUGS, SCORPIONS, SPIDER BEETLES, SILVERFISH (FIREBRATS), CENTIPEDES, MILLIPEDES, EARWIGS, SOYBUGS (PILLBUGS): Kills up to 4 weeks. Apply on baseboards, cracks and crevices around door and window frames, and other hiding places such as closets in back of and under appliances, sinks and cupboards in kitchens and bathrooms, in basements, apply in hiding places in cracks and crevices, lower walls and dark places. Spray surfaces until wet, but not to the point of run-off.
