GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

USES: Floors, walls, metal surfaces, painted surfaces, exterior bowl surfaces, empty basins, showers, conductive flooring, and lavatory fixtures For institutional use on and nursing homes, schools and colleges, medical and dental offices, and veterinary clinics.

APPLICATION: Use 2 ounces of **TOA II** per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application For disinfecting remove gross filth and then thoroughly wet surfaces. **TOA II** is extremely versatile and can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as soaking The recommended use solution is used. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces unless floors are to be waxed or polished
