DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact other persons. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Following application as a low-pressure or high-pressure spray, do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried. 05/11/07

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FOR DISINFECTING

USES: For use in hospitals and nursing homes, schools and colleges, beauty salons, barber shops, medical and dental offices, farm premises and veterinary clinics. For use on washable hard, nonporous surfaces such as floors, walls, finished woodwork, chairs, countertops, sinks, garbage cans, cabinets, cages, kennel runs, examining tables and surfaces made of plastic, metal, stainless steel, glazed ceramic, glazed enameled surfaces, glazed porcelain, sealed stone and other hard, non-porous surfaces.

APPLICATION: Use 1 ounce of *BEAUCOUP GERMICIDAL DETERGENT* per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. For disinfecting, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits, then thoroughly wet surfaces. *BEAUCOUP GERMICIDAL DETERGENT* is a multi-purpose germicidal detergent and can be applied with a mop, sponge or cloth, or by soaking. The recommended use solution is used once and discarded. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces unless floors are to be waxed or polished.

BEAUCOUP GERMICIDAL DETERGENT is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to pre-clean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical devices prior to sterilization or high-level disinfection.

TUBERCULOCIDAL: This product is tuberculocidal diluted 2 ounces per gallon of water with a 10 minutes contact time at 20°C. Apply as directed above.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Disposable latex or vinyl gloves, gowns, face masks, or eye coverings must be worn during all cleaning of body fluids, blood, and decontamination procedures.

CLEANING PROCEDURE: Blood/body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of *BEAUCOUP GERMICIDAL DETERGENT*. This cleaning may be accomplished with any cleaning solution, including this product.

CONTACT TIME: 10 minutes.

DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIALS: Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

DISINFECTION OF BARBER AND BEAUTYSHOP INSTRUMENTS AND TOOLS

Thoroughly pre-clean instruments/tools. Use dilution rate is 1:128 (1/4 oz. per 32 oz. of water or 8 ml. per liter of water). Completely immerse brushes, combs, shears, clipper blades, razors, tweezers, manicure and other shop tools for 10 minutes at room temperature (or as required by local authorities). After disinfection, remove instruments and rinse thoroughly and let dry. Fresh solution should be prepared daily, or more often if solution becomes diluted or soiled. Prolonged soaking may cause damage to metal instruments.

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DISINFECTION AND DEODOF. ING OF ANIMAL HOUSING FACILITIES, (BARNS, KENNELS, CAGES, HUTCHES):

- 1. Do not use in milking stalls, milking parlors, or milk houses.
- 2. Remove all animals and feeds from premises, trucks, coops, crates, and enclosures.
- 3. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes, and other facilities and fixtures occupied or traversed by animals.
- 4. Empty all troughs, racks, and other feeding and watering appliances.
- 5. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water.
- 6. Saturate all surfaces with the recommended disinfecting solution for a period of 10 minutes.
- 7. Immerse all halters, ropes, and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals, as well as forks, shovels, and scrapers used for removing litter and manure.
- 8. Ventilate buildings, coops, cars, boats, and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry, livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set, or dried.
- 9. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains, and waterers with soap or detergent, and rinse with potable water before reuse.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in securely closed original container. Avoid storage at temperature extremes or in direct sunlight.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label directions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

(1 gallon or less): Do not reuse empty containers. Wrap container and put in trash.

(1 gallon or greater): Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

(Reusable container statement): Container can be reused once the container is empty. Empty container of concentrate into dilution dispenser [specific equipment such as "Simplex dispenser" can be named to replace "dilution dispenser".] Dispenser will automatically dilute a sanitizer [or disinfectant] solution. Remove concentrate label. Refill container with use dilution of concentrate from the dispenser. Replace cap with spray nozzle provided. Place correct use dilution label on the spray bottle.
