

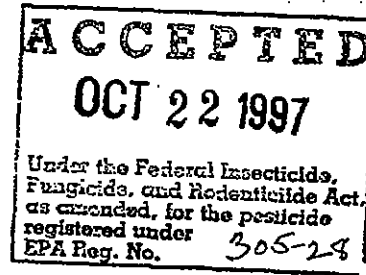

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

Read all directions before using this product.

Apply over all exposed skin to repel biting flies, ticks and mosquitoes. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Do not spray directly on face.

To apply to face: Dispense on palm of hand and spread on face and neck. Do not apply to eyes and mouth. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply to the hands of young children. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing.

Works on clothing too: Spray shirts, pants and hats. For ticks, chiggers and fleas apply to tops of shoes, socks and around openings in outer clothing.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and dispose of in trash.
