The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of Repel Insect Repellent Towelette (EPA Reg. No. 305-29), in connection the DEET Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED), and have concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

General Statement:

Delete all text throughout the label marked with "strikethrough."

<u>Directions for Use section comment(s)</u>:

 In the 1st bulleted paragraph, replace the words "Works on clothing too:" with "For use on outer surfaces of clothing:"

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s):

3. To facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-4, replace this section with:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Store this product in a cool, dry place that is inaccessible to children. **Container Disposal: If empty:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

General Comment(s):

4. Current labels on DEET repellent products tend to dissolve from contact with the repellent (usually liquids). All reregistered DEET product labels must use materials that remain permanent and readable for the reasonable life of the product.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR §156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not be substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find, or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA-approved registration, the website will be referred to EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA). As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number or e-mail address.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.

<u>Individual packages:</u> Tear open envelope and unfold towelette. <u>Multiple packages:</u> Open package and remove single towelette, Seal tightly after removal.

Unfold towelette. Wipe on a thin uniform film over all exposed skin except eye and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over-application. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Do not apply to children's hands.

Works on clothing too: wipe shirts, pants, and hats. For ticks, chiggers and fleas apply to tops of socks and around opening in outer clothing.

After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water.
Wash treated clothing before wearing it again.
