Dear Ms. Lee:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

#### Net Contents/Net Weight Statement section comment(s):

1. The net contents must be expressed in terms of liquid measure (fluid ounces) per individual wipe and also total fluid ounces per package. <sup>1</sup>

#### <u>Directions for Use section comment(s)</u>: To facilitate inclusion of language from the RED for DEET:

- 2. In the 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph of this section, replace the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence with: "Wipe on a thin, uniform film over all exposed skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth."
- 3. In the 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph of this section, replace the 6<sup>th</sup> sentence with: "Avoid over-application of this product."

#### Precautionary Statements, Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals section comment(s):

4. Insert the following text immediately following the 4<sup>th</sup> sentence: "If you suspect a reaction to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent product with you."

#### First Aid Statement comment(s):

5. Delete the existing statement (3<sup>rd</sup> row of this table) starting with "**IF YOU SUSPECT A REACTION TO THIS PRODUCT:**" since this text has already been replaced/updated with revised text that was added to the Precautionary Statements section.

Current labels on DEET repellent products tend to dissolve from contact with the repellent (usually liquids). All reregistered DEET product labels must use materials that remain permanent and readable for the reasonable life of the product.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR §156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not be substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find, or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA-approved registration, the website will be referred to EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA). As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number or e-mail address.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.

<u>Individual packages:</u> Tear open envelope and unfold towelette.

<u>Multiple packages:</u> Open package and remove single towelette,
Seal tightly after removal.

Unfold towelette. Wipe on a thin uniform film over all exposed skin except eye and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over-application. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Do not apply to children's hands.

For use on outer surfaces of clothing: wipe shirts, pants, and hats. For ticks, chiggers and fleas apply to tops of socks and around opening in outer clothing.

After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store this product in a cool, dry place that is inaccessible to children. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: If empty: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
