Repels and protects for hours from mosquitoes, ticks, chiggers, gnats, sand flies, deer flies and other flies. Repels chiggers (mites), ticks and fleas from treated clothing and skin.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT. HOLD UPRIGHT WHEN SPRAYING.** Point directional cap toward surface to be sprayed. Hold can about 6 to 8 inches from skin or clothing while spraying with a slow sweeping motion. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Apply sufficient spray to slightly moisten surface. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. To repel chiggers, ticks and fleas, apply to tops of shoes, socks and around all openings in outer clothing. **TO APPLY TO FACE:** Spray small amounts in palm of hand and spread on face and neck. **DO NOT APPLY TO EYES AND LIPS.** Do not spray directly on face. Do not apply to hands of young children. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS - CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. For external use only. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. In case of contact, flush eyes with plenty of water. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local Poison Control Center. Do not expose treated surfaces near fire or flame until alcohol has evaporated. Do not use on synthetic fabrics such as rayon, 'dynel or spandex. Will not damage cotton, wool or nylon. May damage some plastics such as eyeglass frames, lenses, fishing lines or furniture finishes and painted surfaces.

PHYSICAL & CHEMICAL HAZARDS - EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE: Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° may cause bursting.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
