To apply to face, dispense on palm of hand and spread on face and neck. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply to the hands of young children. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. To not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing.

Works on clothing too: Spray shirts, pants, and hats. For ticks, chiggers and fleas apply to tops of shoes and socks and around opening in outer clothing.
