Please find the enclosed application for notification of the following registration amendments:

A. Pesticide Registration Notice (PR) 2007-4, Final Rule "Pesticide Management and Disposal; Standards for Pesticide Containers and Containment (Nonrefillable Containers):

We have adopted the exact language set forth in PRN 2007-4.

This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirement of 40 CFR 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

B. Pesticide Registration (PR) Notice 98-10:

We have updated the label warranty statement in accordance to the EPA's October 17, 2006 Guidance on Warranty Statements. Additionally, we have added additional products sizes (actually a non-hotification), removed the 1-800-CLEANUP phrase (actually a non-notification), reformatted the label to be consistent with current Agency policy (Label Review Manual) (placed the Directions immediately after the heading Directions for Use) and added two marketing claims (DEET Free and Contains no DEET) and revised one currently approved marketing claim relating to West Nile virus.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR $^{\circ}$ 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of



this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

The marketing claim revision modifies the currently approved claim as follows:

Claim 31: Repels mosquitoes including those that may transmit West Nile Virus for up to six hours, to read

Claim 36: Repels mosquitoes [including those] that may [transmit] [carry] West Nile Virus [for up to six hours]

The addition of the optional claims "DEET Free" and "Contains no DEET" (claims 34 and 35) is consistent with current Biopesticides Division policy as they are 1) factual statements, and 2) have been approved for similar non-DEET repellent products handled by BPPD (for example BullFrog Mosquito Coast EPA Reg. No. 40086-1, BullFrog Mosquito Coast Twilight EPA Reg. No. 40086-2 and Citrepel EPA Reg. No. 84878-2).
