

DIRECTIONS

For washing glassware, dishes, cooking utensils

1. Scrape and rinse to remove excess food.
2. Wash with a nonionic detergent like: Hi-Phen Rinse, Hi-Phen Acid Rinse, or All Purpose Detergent.
3. Rinse with clean warm water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 ounce to 4 gallons of water (200 p.p.m.). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

NOTE: A water rinse following step 4 is not permitted under section H 96.16 (2) (c) 2 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

OTHER USES

Where infectious diseases are present wash infected area or utensils with solution of 1 oz. HI-PHEN to each gallon of water. This is 800 ppm.

Use HI-PHEN SANITIZER and solution to sanitize glassware, dishes, garbage cans, refrigerators, toilet seats, food storage bins. To kill odors caused by mould or decay, remove cause of odor wash or spray with HI-PHEN SANITIZER at 800 ppm. For toilet seats use 800 ppm.

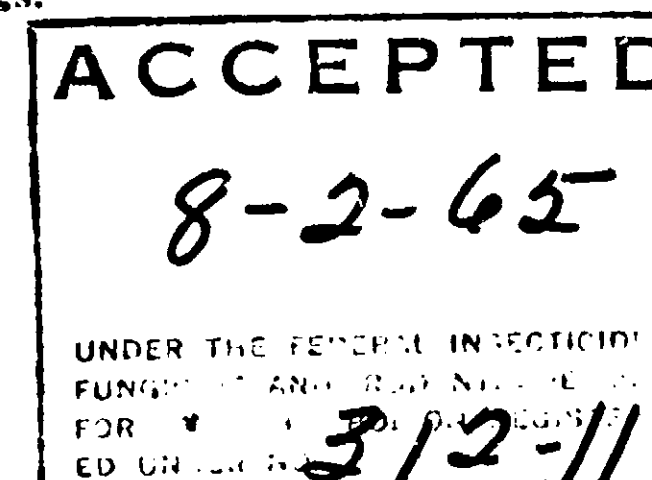
