DIRECTIONS

The presence of moles is indi-
cated either by a network of
ridges in the turf or (when bur-
rowing deeply) by a series of
conical mounds of earth pushed
up from below.

Surface Ridges-Runways in which
moles are active may be deter-
mined by collapsing the ridge at
scattered points about the prem-
ises. The next day some of the
ridged-tunnels will be recon-
structed at these points. Care-
fully punch a hole in the top of
active tunnels, drop in three
tablets of bait, and carefully
close the hole. Take care not to
again collapse the tunnel or
allow loose soil to cover the
bait.

Deep Tunnels - Remove center
plug from the conical mound
with the aid of a long-handled
spoon and drop three tablets of
bait into the underground tunnel.
Close opening with rock or sod.

If less than ten minutes have passed since the
poison was taken, give a tablespoonful of salt in
a glass of warm water. Have victim lie down in
a quiet, darkened room and keep him warm. Call
a physician immediately.
