DIRECTIONS

The presence of moles is indicated either by a network of ridges in the turf or (when burrowing deeply) by a series of conical mounds of earth pushed up from below.

Surface Ridges-Runways in which moles are active may be determined by collapsing the ridge at scattered points about the premises. The next day some of the ridged-tunnels will be reconstructed at these points. Carefully punch a hole in the top of active tunnels, drop in three tablets of bait, and carefully close the hole. Take care not to again collapse the tunnel or loose soil to cover the allow bait.

Deep Tunnels - Remove center plug from the conical mound with the aid of a long-handled spoon and drop three tablets of bait into the underground tunnel. Close opening with rock or sod.
