**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** 

FOR DISINFECTING PREMISES: Remove gross filth from surfaces prior to disinfecting. Prepare a solution of 134 ounces disinfectant to one gallon of water. Wet surface thoroughly with the disinfecting solution and allow to remain for 10 minutes.

FLOORS: When mopping or scrubbing use 134 ounces Disinfectant to each gallon of water in the bucket.

TOILET ROOMS, WATER CLOSETS and URINALS: Wash the closet and urinal bowis regularly, with a solution of 134 ounces of Disinfectant in each gallon of water, leaving the solution in the bowl as long as possible. Scrub the floor and seat frequently with this solution. Remove residual bowl water from toilet before application of disinfectant.

GARBAGE RECEPTACLES: To aid in deodorization, sprinkle with the solution in the proportion of 2 ounces of Disinfectant to each gallon of water. Rinse the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in the can.

TYPHOID SICKROCN: In disinfecting of bed frames, clothing, utensils, rooms, bed clothes, use 3 ources of Disinfectant to a gallon of water.




DIRECTIONS: By cup, swab, or plunger, empty bowl of as much water as possible before using ZEN. Saturate swab with ZEN while holding over toilet or urinal. Rub or scour, being sure to get under rim. Flush. The swab should be rinsed in clear water after each use. In extremely bad conditions, allow ZEN to stand in contact with toilet about five minutes before swabbing and flushing. Used as di-rected, will disinfect toilet bowl or urinal.


Not to be used on sinks, lavatories, bath tubs, or any porcelain surface. Use on vitreous ware only.
