**DIRECTIONS**

**TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, FRUITFLIES, GNATS and FLYING MOTHS:** Direct spray upward into air of closed room, spraying in all directions 5 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 10 minutes to confine aerosol mist.

**DO NOT REMAIN IN TREATED AREAS. VENTILATE TREATED AREAS BEFORE RE-ENTERING.**

**TO KILL ROACHES, ANTS, SPIDERS and SILVERFISH:** Thoroughly spray all insect hiding places and trails, under and behind equipment and fixtures including cracks, dark corners, under drainboards, counters, cabinets, tables, shelves, pipes, in and around drains, moist areas, refuse containers and where they crawl as they come out of hiding or enter area. Repeat treatments as necessary to maintain effective control.

**WARNING:** Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 120° F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using Insekton in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

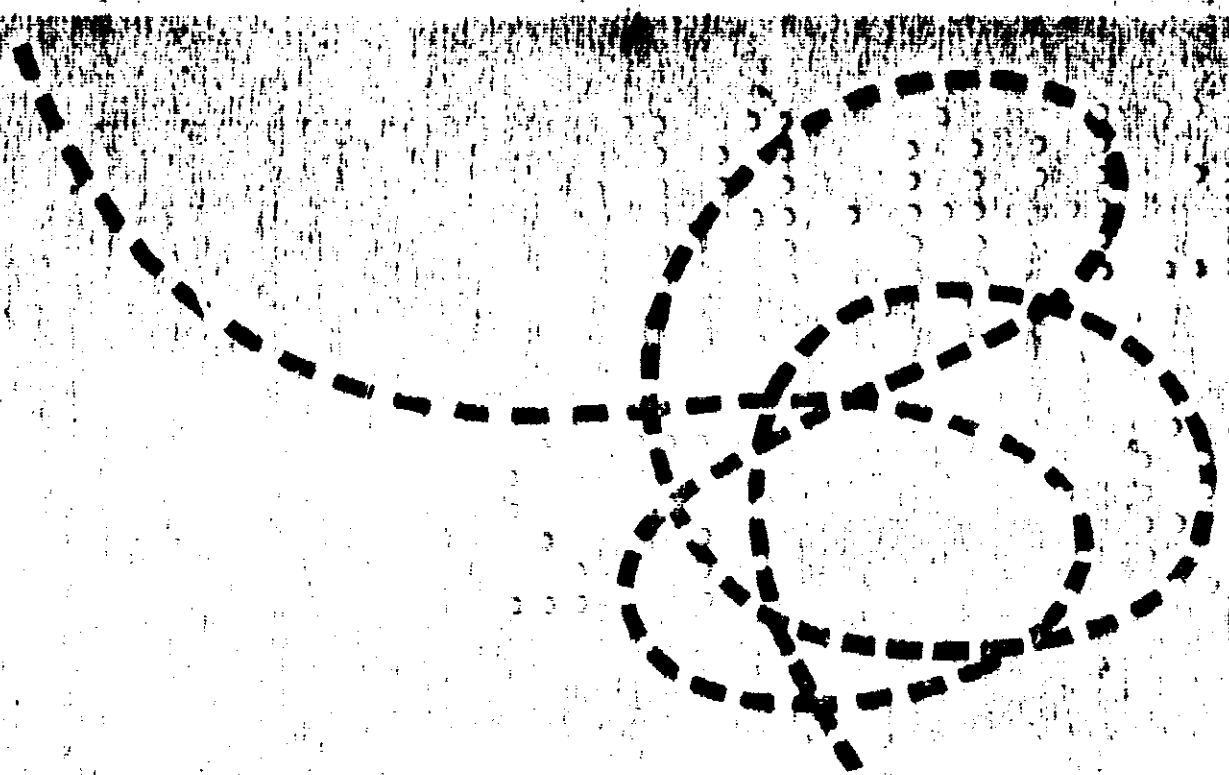
